 - c) Destruction of high conservation values in forestry operations.
 - d) Significant conversion of forests to plantations or non-forest uses.
 - e) Introduction of genetically modified organisms into forestry operations.
 - f) Violation of any of the main ILO conventions, as defined in the Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work, 1998.
- Establish objectives of continuous improvement oriented to the quality of our services, to the reduction of the environmental impact of our activities, being, in addition, consistent with nature, and with this policy that will be reviewed annually by the Management.
